Re: DHS Call for Nominations for DHS Maternity Newborn Clinical Network (MNCN)

I am forwarding to you a call for nomination from Department of Human Services for two GP representatives, one an Obstetrician who provides intrapartum obstetric care in a non-metropolitan health service and one who provides shared antenatal care in a large regional or metropolitan setting. I hope you will consider nominating a GP from your division who is active in this area. Please send your nominations to us by 4pm 27 May 2008. I have attached the relevant information from DHS.

GPV can submit one non-metropolitan and one regional or metropolitan Victorian nomination to DHS. If we receive more than one nomination from each area, the GPV Board will vote to select the nomination to be passed on to DHS. We have asked you to submit your nominations to us before DHS's deadline so that there is time for this process to occur if necessary. So that board members can be properly informed about the nominees' experience in the field of Obstetrics and representation work, GPs should include a brief, targeted CV with their nomination, as well as the other documentation required by DHS.
