

# MALE STEOPOROSIS!

## Volunteers needed for a clinical research study:

- 1** Are you a male, aged 65 or older?
- 2** Does any one of these risk factors for osteoporosis apply to you?
  - Older than 75 years
  - A family member has had an osteoporotic fracture
  - Smoke more than 15 cigarettes a day
  - Have a low bone mineral density (BMD)
  - Have a low body weight with a body mass index of less than 20
- 3** Are you able to walk unassisted?
- 4** Has your weight been stable for the past year?
- 5** Are you prepared to participate in a 2 year clinical study?

If you have answered “yes” to all 5 of these questions you may be able to provide valuable assistance with research in male osteoporosis.
