## If you are Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander you can get **CHEAPER** or **FREE** PBS Medications

Your GP Practice **MUST** be registered in the Indigenous Health Practice Incentive Program or you can go to your local Aboriginal Health Service.

## How do I get Close the Gap Scripts?

You can register for Close the Gap Scripts if:

- You see a doctor at a registered GP Practice on the Indigenous Health Practice Incentive Program (IHPIP) or an Aboriginal Health Service
- You are of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- You have an existing chronic disease or are **at risk** of developing a chronic disease

Speak to your GP for more information or to register for the PBS Close the Gap Scripts.

If your GP does not know of this initiative, they can call their local Division of General Practice.

To access **free** medication you need to have a current Centrelink Health Care Card or Pension Card. All Aboriginal community are eligible for **cheaper** medications. However medicines not on the PBS and other charges like brand price premiums are not covered.
